When: Tuesday, Sept.19th 2023 at 6pm Where: Harvey High School auditorium


There will be incentives for attending to include books and writing supplies for all ages.

Your blood saves lives!



This is a devastating disease that affects more than 100,000 people of color across the United States. Sickle Cell Anemia is a chronic lifelong disease that can cause extreme pain, frequent infections, vision impairment, organ damage and death.

Sick Cell requires ongoing blood transfusions to replace the rapidly dying red blood cells caused by the disease. The donated blood must be a very close match to the patients' blood.

IMPORTANT:

Matching blood types for Sickle Cell patients is **27 times** more likely when the donor is a person of color!

Why Should I Vote! November 7, 2023: A Critical Day in Ohio Law Making History
